Carman Fair Demolition Derby Checklist

Number on car: Left side, right side, and top of vehicle.
All Glass Removed (Windshield Optional) If the windshield is removed a
heavy screen must be installed in front of the driver – ½ width of the opening
Heavy screen on Drivers Door Window – a seatbelt "mesh" will also be allowed
Gas Tank Removed or ahead of rear axle behind front seat.
fastened securely – no bungee cords or tarp straps
Electric fuel pumps are allowed but must have a separate power switch that is
clearly marked & accessible by reaching in cab from window
1 or 2 - 12 volt battery fastened securely and covered - no bungee cords or tarp
straps.
Reinforced bumpers –Tie bars & trailer hitches removed
Doors Fastened- welded, bolted or chained securely
Suspension must be free and of original build – no alterations allowed
Hood & trunk to be chained or bolted. There must be a sufficient size hole in the
hood to facilitate fire control.
Brakes must work on all wheel positions
Car interior must be clean of all glass and debris
No extra weight or reinforcements allowed
Rad in original position
Transmission coolers are allowed – must be securely mounted and hoses
clamped properly
Hole in hood to facilitate fire control
Fire extinguisher – optional. If mounted, the bracket shall not allow the
extinguisher to be dislodged and create a danger to the driver
Seat belt – shoulder belt is preferred
Helmet – must be in reasonable condition, with a strap and the strap used when
worn
Hole in roof – must be large enough to allow flag to be raised through
Red & white flags – provided by officials
Crossbar behind seat is permissible, not mandatory. Due to the age and fatigue
of some vehicles, a reasonable means of use of a "crossbar" is allowed. Such as
the Officials deem the "crossbar" to constitute severe reinforcement of the
vehicle, alterations must.
Trucks are subject to the same consideration
Any areaches installed MIICT NOT be helted through to the frame



- □ Driver door painted white (exception white cars, door painted black)
- ☐ The driver's door may also have a "protector bar" (channel) welded to the door exterior. The channel must be tapered at each end and will only serve as extra protection to the driver. Such as reinforcement of the vehicle is seen, alterations must be preformed prior to participation
